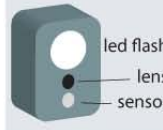

Tracking Techniques



Radio Collars [radiotelemetry]
Allows scientists to pinpoint tigers location using GPS. Data is sent from the collar to satellites to laptops allowing rangers to track the tigers position.



Infrared Cameras
Remote cameras record tiger numbers and behaviour. Animals breaking the infra beam are captured by the camera.



Prey Count
Monitoring remains of prey gives a good indication of their numbers. Deer and boar as well as small mammals, birds and fish are all food sources.

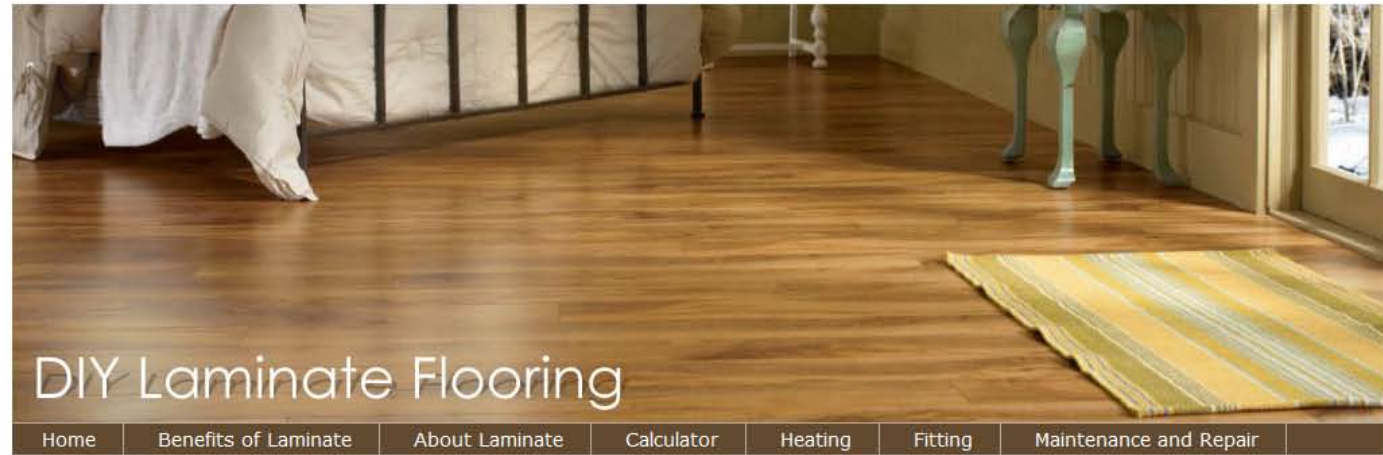

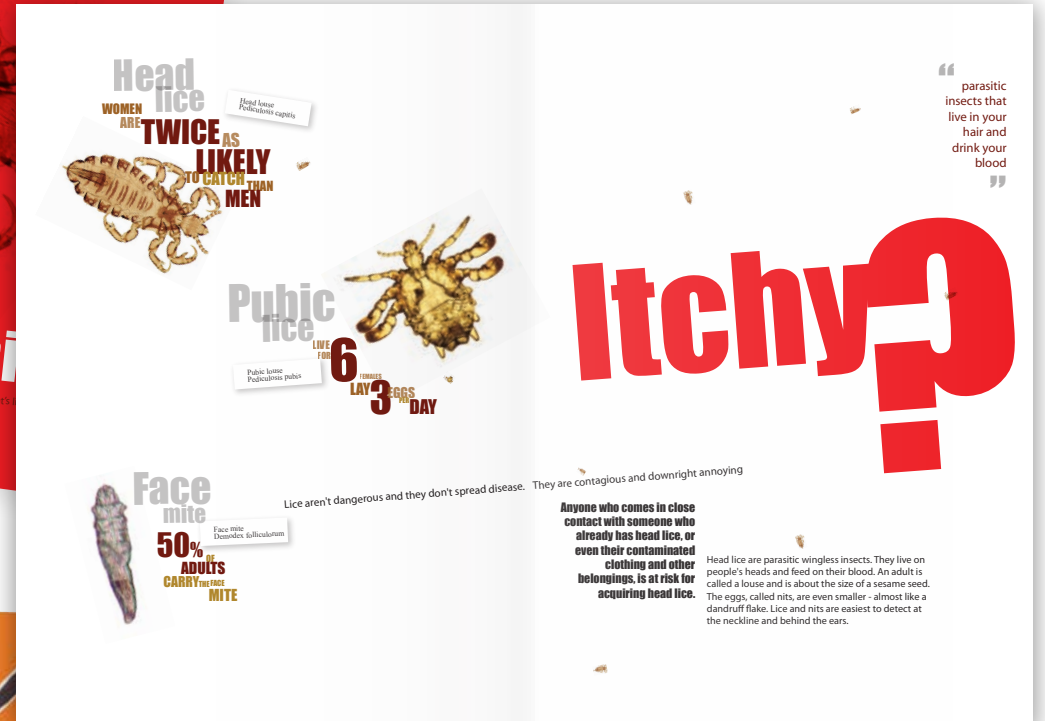
